Health Update from Father Kalscheuer

I'm not sure if you have heard how sick I am and have been. So many times the rumors get way ahead of the facts. After many weeks of testing and trips in and out of St Mary's the doctors have finally concluded that I have prostate cancer and that it is pretty well scattered all over the body. Even so they are hoping that when they put together the right treatment, that they will be able to control it and prevent it from spreading further and give me additional good years.

Treatments began Friday, April 15, with a shot in the belly of leuprolide. I can only take the leuprolide shot once every 6 months so I asked the doctor to line me up for about 20 of those. That would get me to about age 88. The other medication is a daily pill called bicalutamide. They have me on morphine to handle the pain. I can't say that I feel too bad since they put me on the morphine. I sleep very well but have little or no appetite and am very lazy.

Until all this came up I was looking forward to helping out Fr. Wendler this weekend, 4/30 and May 1. Instead I now ask for your prayers. Hopefully God will continue to permit me to grow older in His service and give me the strength to accept graciously what remains of His will for me. I was blessed to have spent more than half my priesthood with you at St. Joe's. The life God gave me there was more than I could have ever imagined. May He now continue to bless us all and always. ~ Fr. K
